

CALIFORNIA EMPLOYER PULL NOTICE PROGRAM (EPN)



WHAT IS IT?



The EPN is a **mandatory program** for employers of commercial vehicle operators (Class A, Class B and commercial class C licenses) with more than one power unit or more than 3 towed vehicles/trailers in the state of California. The program is optional for employers of non-commercially licensed drivers. It was created to ensure drivers have valid licenses, recognize problem drivers and/or improper driving behavior all with a goal to improve public safety and minimize liability (accidents)



WHEN AM I NOTIFIED

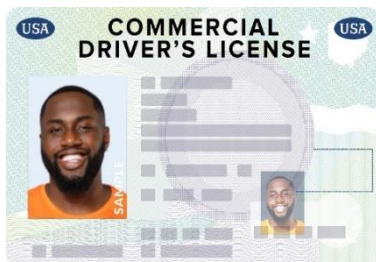
The EPN gives notice to employers when an enrolled driver is:

- Convicted of a moving violation.
- Involved in an accident.
- Has had their driver's license suspended or revoked.
- Fails to appear for a court date



WHY DOES THIS MATTER?

The EPN Program is a crucial tool designed to help employers monitor the driving records of their employees. This program allows employers to receive timely updates on the driving status of their drivers. By doing so, it enhances safety and compliance with state regulations. Furthermore, safe, and responsible commercial vehicle operators also tend to pay **less** in insurance premiums.
